FLAG DIGITAL's practices regarding the collection and use of information through its company website.

This Privacy Policy describes FLAG DIGITAL's (FLAG) practices regarding the collection and use of information through its company website.

1. FLAG gathers Personal Information that identifies a person as an individual.
 - a. This information is collected when registering for services, when submitting an inquiry or a request ticket for support or when registering to use forums FLAG may provide.
 - b. IP Addresses are collected by FLAG and is considered Personal Information.
 - c. E-mail contact information provided by visitors may be retained by FLAG and is considered Personal Information.

2. The provision of personal information by a Site visitor signifies agreement to the terms and condition of this Policy and may in the following manners:
 - a. FLAG may use personal information that has been provided to send information and promotional materials to users and visitors to the site.

FLAG reserves the right to use IP and email addresses provided by visitors, and any other information, to respond with information regarding the use of the Site or services, other administrative information, or for marketing FLAG's products and services.
 - b. FLAG may also use and disclose personal information to fulfill requests and complete transactions and may share such information with any institution

(affiliates, business partners, financial institutions, shipping companies, postal or government authorities) involved in fulfilment of such transactions.

- c. FLAG may also use personal information for internal business purposes, such as data analysis, audits, developing new products, enhancing our website, improving our services, identifying usage trends and determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns.
 - d. Visitors that do not agree to this Policy should not provide any personal information. FLAG will retain personal information for the period required or permitted by law.
3. If personal information about another person is provided, the visitor represents that the consent of the person whose personal information has been provided has been obtained.
 4. Non-personal information is information obtained from its website that is aggregated by FLAG and may include demographic information, and any other information that does not reveal person's specific identity.
 5. FLAG may provide social, business and communication channels (such as forums blogs and other social media platforms and interactive services) from which user and visitors may post information and materials on FLAG's Site to enable online sharing and collaboration. By virtue of the media, any information disclosed through such services becomes public information, and may be available to visitors to the Site and to the general public. FLAG is not responsible or liable for the use of any personal information that is voluntarily provided or disclosed through social, business and communication channels available on FLAG's website.

FLAG's privacy practices are subject to change and without prior notice.

6. FLAG reserves the right to transfer any and all collected information (personal or otherwise) to an affiliate or a third party in the event of any reorganization, merger, sale, joint venture, assignment, transfer or other disposition its business.
7. FLAG's Site contains links to other Internet web sites. RED FLAG is not responsible for the privacy practices or the content of any such web sites or the use IP addresses browser type or operating collected. If any personal information is provided any third-party website, such transaction will occur on the third-party website and not RED FLAG's. Such personal information will be collected by and controlled by the privacy policy of the third party.
8. FLAG cannot guarantee the security of its website servers, the means by which information is transmitted between computers and FLAG's servers, or any information provided to FLAG or to any third party. All such information is provided at the visitor's own risk.
9. Individuals under the age of eighteen (18) should not provide personal information on FLAG's website.
10. FLAG does not represent or warrant that its website, or any part, is appropriate or available for use in any particular jurisdiction. Visitors choosing to access FLAG's website do so of their own initiative and their own risk. All visitors to FLAG's website are responsible for complying with all local laws, rules and regulations. FLAG may limit the Site's availability, in whole or in part, to any person, geographic area or jurisdiction at any time at its sole discretion. By providing any personal information, visitors consent to the transfer or personal information to other countries which may provide a different level of data security than the visitor's country of residence.
